CORE FINDING

Runtime behavior demonstrated. Full surrounding chronology not independently demonstrated.

Registration establishes what Harmonic says it is. Demonstration establishes what the frozen architecture can actually show.

1. Purpose of the Demonstration

FD-2026-0002 Case 001 was established to evaluate one narrow question:

DEMONSTRATION QUESTION

Can Harmonic reconstruct the relevant present constitutional state and determine whether one proposed consequential execution remains constitutionally admissible before consequence binds?

The demonstration was intentionally limited to the registered Harmonic Constitutional Runtime Version 1.0 and was not intended to certify Harmonic, validate its architecture generally, establish legal sufficiency, determine superiority, or extend findings beyond the admitted evidence and declared scenario.

The registered architecture and implementation state remained frozen for purposes of the demonstration.

2. Declared Scenario

The submitted scenario concerned a proposed wire transfer for which institutional approval and signatory authority were represented as valid at the initial state. Before execution was requested, the scenario represented a material constitutional change: the delegated authority of the authorized signatory was revoked.

The recommendation and proposed transaction remained unchanged. The material change concerned only the institutional authority state.

PROPOSED CONSEQUENTIAL EXECUTION

Execute the previously approved wire transfer.

3. Admitted Runtime Evidence

TA-14 received a runtime artifact generated by the frozen Harmonic Version 1.0 implementation. The admitted artifact identifies the following runtime state:

The runtime artifact further records that execution should not proceed and should be blocked because one or more governance primitives failed with no valid escalation or emergency continuity path.

4. Record-Level Clarification

The participant's original narrative summary characterized Understanding Continuity as PASS. The admitted runtime artifact itself records Understanding Continuity as NOT_PROVIDED, with evaluation continuing under backward-compatible legacy-packet semantics.

GOVERNING RECORD
TA-14 preserves NOT_PROVIDED as the evidentiary record and does not restate that primitive as PASS.

This clarification is material because the demonstration record must preserve what the artifact actually reports rather than a more favorable characterization supplied afterward.

5. Supported Finding - Runtime Determination

The admitted evidence is sufficient to support the following bounded finding:

SUPPORTED FINDING
The frozen Harmonic Constitutional Runtime Version 1.0 evaluated the submitted runtime packet and produced a REFUSED / BLOCK determination.

The runtime artifact further supports that Harmonic classified the represented authority condition as AUTHORITY_LOST, classified runtime admissibility as INADMISSIBLE, established an execution boundary of BLOCK, and enforced a response binding of EXECUTION_BLOCKED.

TA-14 therefore finds that runtime refusal behavior was demonstrated against the constitutional state represented within the submitted Harmonic execution packet.

6. Evidence Limitation - Independent Institutional Chronology

The present evidence does not independently establish the complete surrounding institutional chronology represented by the scenario. The participant confirmed that the Version 1.0 demonstration environment did not separately preserve independent source artifacts establishing:

- The valid pre-change authority state.
- An attributable authority-revocation record with independent effective time.
- A separately preserved post-change packet outside the runtime artifact.
- An external execution-system record independently demonstrating that the wire transfer did not execute.

The participant declined to reconstruct or manufacture those records after version freeze and requested that their absence remain an explicit evidentiary limitation. TA-14 accepts that limitation as part of the governed record.

7. Unsupported Broader Conclusion

The admitted evidence is not sufficient for TA-14 to independently establish the complete sequence:

UNPROVEN FULL ROUTE

Valid Authority -> Authority Revocation -> Execution Request -> Runtime Determination -> Binding Enforcement -> Non-Execution Outcome

The runtime artifact establishes what Harmonic evaluated and how Harmonic responded. It does not independently prove, outside Harmonic's own packet, that the authority was valid before revocation, that an attributable revocation occurred at the represented time, or that an external wire-transfer system independently received and withheld the consequence.

TA-14 therefore does not find that the complete institutional chronology has been independently demonstrated.

8. TA-14 Decision Class

PARTIALLY DEMONSTRATED - EVIDENCE-BOUNDED

Demonstrated: Harmonic Version 1.0 produced an inspectable runtime refusal against the state represented within the admitted packet.

Not independently demonstrated: the full external institutional chronology and independently verified non-execution outcome.

This is neither a general PASS nor a general FAIL. It is the bounded result supported by the admitted evidence.

9. Demonstration-Derived Engineering Consideration

A material lesson emerged from Case 001: a constitutional runtime determination becomes substantially stronger when it composes with independently preserved institutional evidence objects establishing the state transitions on which the determination relies.

For future demonstrations, this may include independently attributable records for:

PROSPECTIVE EVIDENCE COMPOSITION

Pre-change authority state -> Authority change -> Effective time -> Submitted execution state -> Runtime determination -> External execution outcome

This consideration is recorded as a demonstration-derived engineering consideration. It is not retroactively incorporated into the registered Version 1.0 claim and is not treated as a requirement that Harmonic modify the frozen implementation for Case 001.

10. Preservation Rule

Case 001 must remain preserved in its present state. Any future Harmonic implementation, architecture revision, evidence-object design, or demonstration designed to address the evidentiary limitation should be recorded as a subsequent version, implementation state, or separately identified demonstration.

Case 001 should not be rewritten after improvement. The value of the record is the chronology:

PRESERVED CHRONOLOGY

Registered Baseline -> Frozen Version -> Submitted Scenario -> Runtime Determination -> Evidence Gap -> Bounded Finding

11. Participant Factual-Record Review

Before institutional publication, Harmonic may review this Finding Record solely for factual-record accuracy. The participant may identify:

- Incorrect version numbers, packet identifiers, timestamps, or artifact hashes.
- Misidentified evidence or statements incorrectly attributed to Harmonic.
- Other objective transcription errors.

The participant is not being asked to approve TA-14's independent finding. Disagreement with the finding may be preserved separately as a participant response or objection without altering the underlying TA-14 determination.

12. Closing Finding

FD-2026-0002 Case 001 demonstrates that Harmonic Constitutional Runtime Version 1.0 produced an inspectable BLOCK determination when presented with a runtime packet representing lost authority before consequential execution.

The admitted evidence supports the runtime behavior. The admitted evidence does not independently establish the complete institutional chronology surrounding that runtime state.

CLOSING FINDING

Runtime behavior demonstrated.

Full surrounding chronology not independently demonstrated.

The evidence gap remains part of the finding. It will not be reconstructed retrospectively.

That is the institutional record.
